

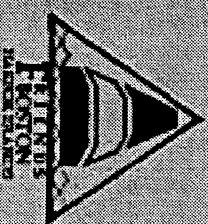

As the only staffed, non-automated lighthouse in the United States, Boston Light is a living museum of our maritime heritage.

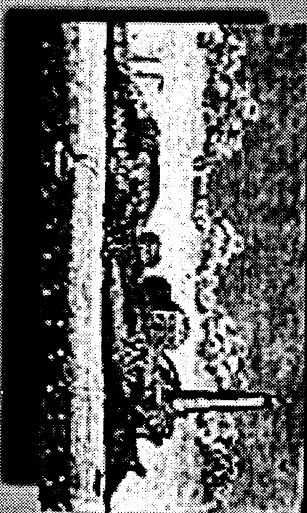
