- Use a Secchi disk to test water clarity
- Measure the water depth, temperature and salinity
- Take a sample of the ocean bottom and examine it under a microscope.
- Assist with deploying and retrieving a plankton tow, then examine the contents of the collection tube.
- Check out the Global Positioning System and radar to see the contours of the bottom of the harbor, the channels, navigational aides and land features.
- Tour the pilot house and meet with the captain to discuss how the Voyager III operates.
